

The President of the University of Southern California reports to the Board of Trustees and is responsible for the academic and administrative leadership of the University. Reporting to the President are the following:



Key Priorities

The President will lead the development and implementation of a shared vision to achieve academic preeminence across areas of strategic importance. The President leads the University, manages institutional resources, and serves as the chief fundraising officer. The President will enhance outstanding faculty and educational programs. The next President will have the opportunity to focus on the following areas of strategic priority:

Leadership and Strategic Vision

- Lead by example with moral clarity, courage, and integrity.
- Demonstrate a willingness to engage frequently with trustees, faculty, staff, students, alumni, and community leaders on issues impacting the University.
- Ensure USC adapts and embraces new operating models for the future of higher education.
- Uphold and articulate the values of free speech and academic freedom, fostering an environment that encourages learning and open dialogue.
- · Marshall resources and ensure sustainable growth.

Academic Excellence

- Ensure schools and units are aligned on the overall academic objective of the University, including the shared commitment to a grounding in the liberal arts and the strategic advantages of USC's interdisciplinary culture.
- Encourage interdisciplinary collaboration within and between schools and capitalize on the strengths of professional, STEM, and humanities programs.
- Ensure academic leaders are in constant pursuit of new channels of innovation in undergraduate and graduate education.
- Maintain preeminence of academic research within USC's areas of strategic competence.
- Demonstrate a clear commitment to shared governance.

Medical Education and Healthcare Service

- Continue to evolve the medical enterprise for optimal performance.
- Increase the capacity and efficiency of the institution's medical research apparatus.
- Drive positive health outcomes at USC and across the Los Angeles metro area through USC's medical enterprise.

Fundraising and Community Engagement (continued)


- Foster deep connections between the University and the local community, emphasizing USC's role as a community leader.

- Demonstrated track record in recruiting and retaining talent.
- Proven history of fundraising success and the personal qualities that indicate strength in this area, with an understanding that it is a critical and key responsibility of this leadership role. This includes experience establishing partnerships.
- Proven track record of working effectively and collaboratively with a Board.
- Ability to foster a culture of academic excellence, research, and unique experiential opportunities.
- Outstanding communication skills, including public speaking and active listening.
- Demonstrated track record in engaging leaders and teams in accomplishing a shared vision.
- An analytical strategist who can anticipate trends, manage change, and innovate.
- Crisis management experience, at scale.

- Exceptional fortitude, courage, and judgment in navigating the current academic and political environment.
- Fully committed to developing an environment of ethics, accountability, and transparency.

The ideal candidate will possess the following personal qualities:

- Empathy, integrity, and approachability, with a genuine commitment to building relationships on- and off-campus.
- A consultative, innovative, and transparent style of decision-making that inspires trust.
- Visionary leadership with the ability to unify, energize, and engage a broad range of constituents.
- A deep appreciation for Los Angeles and the West and USC's historic role in the communities in which its campuses are located.
- An enthusiasm for being accessible to faculty, staff, students, alumni, and community members.
- Appreciation for teaching, scholarship, and academic service.
- Preferably, a terminal degree or equivalent academic credentials.
